“There Is a Boomerang Spirit”

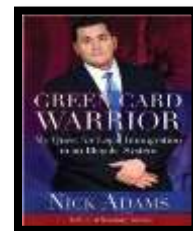
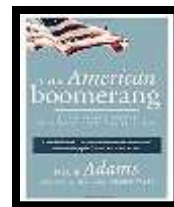

On September 11th, Bar-W welcomed former Australian Nick Adams as our speaker. Mr. Adams is the CEO of the Foundation for Liberty and American Greatness (FLAG). The current goal of the foundation is to get traditional values out to schoolchildren with the long-term goal of creating knowledgeable voters to win future elections.

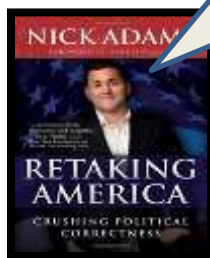
Mr. Adams' talk, which was very well received by the Bar-W audience, reviewed some current moral and political problems in the United States as well as hopes for a positive turnaround. One of his latest projects is an effort to bring children a knowledge of the history and revolutionary political ideas of our nation's Founders, which are so neglected in our public schools.

His organization FLAG has created a *Student's Constitution*, which is our Constitution written in everyday English to make it suitable for fifth graders. It has already been received by over five thousand schoolchildren. FLAG also makes available *A Patriot's Coloring Book* featuring President Donald Trump and Melania Trump on the cover. Future plans include a student's version of the Declaration of Independence.

Mr. Adams is the author of three books, including *Green Card Warrior: My Quest for Legal Immigration in an Illegals' System*, which tells about his long and very expensive effort to legally become an American citizen. *The American Boomerang: How the World's Greatest Turnaround Nation Will Do It Again*, with foreword by Allen West; and *Retaking America: Crushing Political Correctness*, with foreword by Dennis Prager.
